Boiler Operator 2 year program

A Boiler operator oversees the operation and maintenance of boilers, which are used to generate steam or heat air, in commercial, industrial, and institutional settings. As a Boiler Operator, their job involves monitoring and regulating boiler systems for proper functioning, troubleshooting problems, and performing routine maintenance tasks.

They will also install, troubleshoot and maintain:

- 1) Boilers Operation, data gathering, safety practices
- 2) Boiler Auxiliaries Controls, control logic, feed pumps, heaters, water treatment
- 3) Repair and Maintenance Refractory, pipefitting welding, hand tools, non-licensed electrical (fuses, relays, switches, circuit breakers), oiling, testing, inspection, etc.

Additional Work hours are also required according to the individual employers needs

The Average Journeymen's wage thru June 2025 is \$37.71. An apprentice starts at 80% (\$24.51) of that with 5%-pay increases every 1000 on the job hours and 72 school hours.
