All applications and documents will be reviewed. Qualified applicants are then ranked on the list of eligible applicants based on their application documentation. Applicants will be placed for interviews with training agents in the order of their rank in the Ranked Pool of Eligibles, according to the geographical preference indicated on their application. You will be notified of your rank in the eligibility pool in writing. Applicants who do not meet the minimum qualifications will not be admitted to the applicant pool and will be notified in writing. Notification will include the reasons(s) for rejection and the appeal rights available.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

To meet the minimum qualifications the following documentation must be provided:

- 1) Age – Provide a copy of your current driver's license or a copy of your birth certificate;
- 2) Education – Provide a copy of your High School transcript, HS Diploma, College Transcript or Diploma or GED certificate
- 3) Classes – provide a copy of your high school or college transcript verifying successful completion of one full year of high school Algebra, or an equivalent post-high school placement test or course, with a grade of C or better. NOTE: The employer may require a current valid Oregon driver's license.
- 4) Work Hands assessment scoring into level 3 or higher
